The Court of Audit sends its 28th Report with comments to the Walloon Parliament



The 28th Report with comments that the Court of Audit sends to the Walloon Parliament is divided into two parts.

The first part contains accounting and budgetary articles. At first, the Court comments on the approval of general accounts of the Walloon Region and of several depending public services. It then deals with the specific account audits.

In the second part, the Court of Audit reminds of its comments and recommendations made during audits within different sectors. The first audit focuses on the expenses of the secretariat and supporting services of the Walloon government members. The Court also follows up the recovery of wages unduly paid by the Walloon Brabant province. Finally, it analyses the budgetary impact of the local authorities in the Walloon Region as defined by the European system of national and regional accounts.
